Lecture

Prof Rafiq Memon of Dental Faculty, Liaquat University of Medical and Health Sciences, Jamshoro delivered a lecture with the aid of multimedia projector system on the management of Halitosis to an august gathering of dental and medical practitioners at a local hotel on May 11, 2002.

Prof Memon stated that 80% of causes of halitosis emanated from oral cavity. Remaining were due to respiratory, alimentary tract, liver ailments, uncontrolled diabetes, uraemia, ketosis and long sleeping hours. The condition is attributed to volatile sulphur compound emitted by the decomposition of microorganisms and food debris. In order to mask this social menace some people used pan, betel-nut, mouth and breath sprays, some fresheners with their very temporary effect, instead of treating the cause, he regretted. He advised meticulous oral hygiene measures with emphasis on cleaning the back of dorsum of tongue where odorogenic bacteria, plaque, etc. habitat most. He suggested tonsillar irrigation with a special gadget meant for it. To offset halitosis he recommended the use of fresh fibrous fruit as apple, citrous fruits, frequent meals, drinks and talking. He showed some mobile-phone sized gadget for measurement of degree of halitosis for self-assessment.
