Japanese World - First Tooth - Regrowing Drug To Be TESTED On Humans.

Japanese researchers are close to a significant breakthrough in dental medicine with a new drug that can regenerate human teeth.

Developed by Toregem Biopharma, this cutting edge treatment targets the USAG-1 gene (Uterine Sensitization Associated Gene-1), which inhibits tooth growth, allowing new teeth to develop from existing buds. The drug has shown promising results in animal trials and is set to begin human clinical trials in 2024, starting with adults who have congenital tooth loss.

If successful, this drug could revolutionize dental care by offering a natural alternative to dentures & implants..
